## CC4 meets all NIS2 requirements ahead of schedule

### What does NIS2-compliant mean?

The EU's NIS2 Directive sets new standards for the protection of critical infrastructure against cyber threats. It extends the requirements of the previous NIS1 Directive and focuses on higher security measures, rapid incident reporting and greater cooperation between companies and EU countries.
